158 examples of this feature for 1925 are held in the collection; however, no dates are available for them.		
82 examples have two features on left; Eve's Epigrams and Dumb-Bells. Dumb-Bells lists the year as 1925. Also, the last date on these (which is the second from last clipping) are (Dumb-Bells, 6-6 and Eve's Epigrams, 6-23). Dumb-Bells starts being included at 3-22 (it's dates) and Eve's Epigrams starts 1 feature before.		
It's not very clear where 1925 starts, the dates on other features as well as numbering on Gaar Williams Panels are uncertain/varied. The first panel that is counted has subject matter of 'Happy New Year'.		
Gaar Williams Panels are numbered 1-30, and numbering restarts once it reaches 30.
